Senator COONAN—Can you identify any instances where the government or the department have provided exemption for a government agency or a department so that they do not have to use the established coordinated procurement contracting for particular properties or services?

. . .

Senator COONAN—I realise it was a broad question, and it was intentionally so. I invite you to give me a list of exemptions and perhaps the reason.

Dr Watt—We will see what we can do.

Senator COONAN—Is that: yes, you will take it on notice?

Dr Watt—Yes, we will take it on notice. That one is easier than some of the others we have taken on notice.

Senator COONAN—Also if you could indicate how temporary 'temporary' is—Dr Watt—The length of time the exemption is for.

Answer:

As at 27 May 2009 the Government has approved 54 exemptions for procurement of goods and services subject to a coordinated procurement scoping study. These approvals are in accordance with the government's transitional arrangements. These arrangements allow agencies to extend existing contracts for up to 12 months, particularly for relatively low value contracts or where there are no further options to extend to ensure continuity of supply, but require agencies to seek approval from the relevant portfolio Minister and the Minister for Finance and Deregulation to enter into new contracts or exercise contract extension options which go beyond 12 months.

Attached is a list of approvals granted to agencies under these circumstances. It should be noted that often these extensions relate to more specialised procurement requirements and these allow agencies to continue their day-to-day business.
