- a) Can the Committee be provided with a list of official gifts received by Prime Minister Keating, and the ultimate disposition of these gifts? If not, why not?
- b) Can the Committee be provided with a list of official gifts received by Prime Minister Hawke, and the ultimate disposition of these gifts? If not, why not?

Answer: As indicated in answer to question PM48a-h from the Additional Estimates hearings on 23-27 February 2009, records relating to gifts received prior to 1996 are stored on obsolete computer software. Accordingly, retrieving the requested information about Prime Ministers Keating and Hawke would be onerous and time-consuming for the department, and would be an unreasonable diversion of resources.
