Senator CORMANN-While you are taking things on notice, given your responsibility for whole-of-government coordination of decisions, policies and strategic directions, did you ensure that the Department of Health and Ageing was consulted by central agencies in considering this decision?

Answer: The Department of Health and Ageing (Health and Ageing) was not consulted as part of the decision regarding the conversion of Medibank Private Limited (MPL) to a for-profit entity. As this matter related to a change in MPL's status and not to the private health insurance regulatory framework it was considered appropriate that this matter be addressed at arm's length from the policy department.
