

I am not disagreeing with any of that, but the trouble with comparisons solely to benchmarks of the rest of the market or the rest of the world is we do not know what the comparator is. What I am trying to ascertain here is the particular impact of this particular proposal, because we do not know if our markets would not have done slightly better. We do not know if the resources sector would not have suffered quite as much. In recent years the resources sector has, I understand, outperformed a number of the measures you mentioned, hasn't it? It has had a pretty good run.
