Centrelink

Centrelink does not have a separate expense coding for hospitality. Information provided is based on expenses coded under 'Sustenance'. In addition to hospitality, 'Sustenance' includes expenditure on food and drink for training, internal business meetings, staff awards and recognition. For the period of 1 July 2009 to 9 June 2010 Centrelink had over 10,000 sustenance transactions with a total of \$1,026,982.72.

Given the large number of transactions, only the hospitality transactions with a value in excess of \$1,000 have been extracted. The table below provides details of the 34 hospitality transactions for which the amount incurred for hospitality was equal to or greater than \$1,000. The majority of these transactions relate to events conducted in the course of service delivery, such as *Financial Information Seminars* and *Job Expos*.
