Answer:

- 1. It was a recommendation in the Interdepartmental Committee Report "Keep Australia Working" publicly released in October 2009 and adopted by the Government.

- 5. The Department of Education, Employment and Workplace Relations (DEEWR) funded these Expos.
 - a) A total of 22 Expos were planned for the 2009-10 financial year. Costs vary for each Expo depending on the location and suitability of local venues, transport costs and logistic requirements. Total direct costs for the 22 Expos conducted in the 2009-10 financial year are provided in the table below.

- 6. Invitations were issued to 381,399 customers¹ by the Minister for Human Services; 418 employers² were issued invitations by the Minister for Employment and Workplace Relations, and Centrelink issued invitations to several thousand businesses and other organisations.
 - a) The criteria for determining the invitees were:
 - Centrelink customers who are in receipt of Newstart Allowance,
 Youth Allowance ('active job seeker' category) and Disability
 Support Pension ('active job seeker' category) and Parenting
 Payment ('active job seeker' category), and

 employers who are generally regarded as the larger local employers in the region, as determined by the Local Employment Coordinator and DEEWR.

Notes:

- 1 Customers in the Cairns region would have received invitations for both Expos.
- 2 This figure does not distinguish between one-off invitations and invitations to larger employers such as banks and retailers who are invited to most of the Expos.
- 7. The material sent to invitees was prepared by DEEWR and Centrelink.
- 8. On arrival at Jobs Expos, job seekers are issued with a floor plan of the venue showing the location of exhibitors and the Jobs Board, which contains vacant positions. Exhibitors also hand out information about their organisations to job seekers.
- 9. As at 24 June 2010, advice from exhibitors indicates that approximately 8,000 job seekers have been placed in employment as a result of attending the Jobs Expos.
