- a) I understand that Dr Vivienne Thom has temporarily replaced Ian Carnell as Acting Inspector-General of Intelligence and Security. Does she still retain her position as Deputy Commonwealth Ombudsman?
- b) When is the appointment of the new Inspector-General of Intelligence and Security expected to be made?
- c) When was the position advertised?
- d) For how long was it advertised?
- e) How many applications have been received?
- f) Have interviews commenced?

Answer:

- a) Dr Vivienne Thom has retained her position as the Deputy Commonwealth Ombudsman pending the outcome of a merit selection process to identify a permanent replacement for Mr Ian Carnell as the Inspector-General of Intelligence and Security (IGIS), but Dr Thom's appointment as Acting IGIS is on a full-time basis.
- b–f) The position was advertised on 25 March 2010, with applications closing on 9 April 2010. Four applications were received. Interviews have been held. The timing of the announcement of an outcome is a matter for the Government to determine.
