Answer:

- a) Since its establishment as an executive agency on 1 July 2008 to 31 May 2010 OPH has engaged thirteen consultancies valued at more than \$10,000 with a total contract value of \$555,895.80 (GST inclusive). The attachment sets out details of the name of the consultant, the subject matter of the consultancy, the duration of the contract, the cost of the consultancy and the procurement method. It would be an unreasonable diversion of resources for the agency to provide details of all consultancies valued at less than \$10,000.
- b) The attachment sets out the amount spent (paid) on consultancies and the value of contracts awarded, both as totals and by financial years 2008/09 and 2009/10.

- c) The agency is up to date with its reporting requirements on the Government's tenders and contracts website. The figures on this site are correct.
- d) The attachment sets out the number of consultancies planned for the current calendar year (2010). The annual procurement plan for 1 July 2010 to 30 June 2011 was published on AusTender on 29 June 2010. The attachment identifies the subject matter, duration, projected cost and method of procurement and name where known.
