**Senator FIFIELD:** Would you be able to take on notice a list of the organisations that have been consulted—the disability organisations as well as those groups that have been consulted in preparing this package of measures?

## **Answer**

- 1 The following organisations have had some involvement in providing advice on disability access to Parliament House:
  - (a) CRS Australia (formerly known as the Commonwealth Rehabilitation Service)—conducted a Functional Access Assessment of Parliament House, January 2009 and provided a supplementary report in April 2009;
  - (b) Guida Moseley Brown Architects—has been engaged to prepare a costed, prioritised list of required works based upon previous reports on disabled access and height safety issues at Parliament House (work currently in progress);
  - (c) Morris-Goding Accessibility Consulting (draft report May 2011); and
  - (d) DPS employees with technical expertise in hearing loop technology undertook an Audio Frequency Induction Loop Audit, February 2009.
