Can you give examples of Commonwealth-state bodies where you have been asked to, or when they were established, it was determined that you would be the auditor for those groups?

**Answer:**

A number of bodies that involve 'state participants' (mainly through involvement by councils) have their financial statements audited by agreement under s.20 of the Auditor-General Act. These include National Environmental Protection Council Service Corporation and Health Workforce Australia.
