**Question:**

On what date did Official Diamond Jubilee portraits of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II and His Royal Highness The Duke of Edinburgh become available under the Constituents' Request Program. How many portraits have been requested since that date. What has it cost to make these portraits available through the Constituents' Request Program.

**Answer:**

The Official Diamond Jubilee portraits became available under the Constituents' Request Program on 18 April 2012.

As at 31 May 2012 1,144 copies were ordered of the official Diamond Jubilee Portrait of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II and 925 copies were ordered of the official Diamond Jubilee Portrait of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II and His Royal Highness The Duke of Edinburgh.

As at 31 May 2012 the total cost to print the Diamond Jubilee portraits was \$2,233.00 (GST exclusive).
