Senator JOHNSTON: To put the accounting standards to one side, you have rendered to the Commonwealth accounts for work done on air warfare destroyer.

Answer:

From 2006-07 to 2010-11, ASC AWD Shipbuilder Pty Ltd invoiced \$930m to the Commonwealth in respect to AWD.
