Mr Kenny: We have already provided the advice of when the review was finalised. What I said is that I do not know when the review started. I have taken that on notice.

Senator RONALDSON: You will also take on notice whether there was actually a security review done on the BAE system before it was put in, the \$7 million system.

Mr Kenny: Yes.

Answer

As indicated in response to Question 38, the Information Security Review commenced in February 2010.

Security aspects of the BAE system were assessed as part of the tender assessment process. These included its ability to control and restrict viewing of selected cameras to selected operators, and how the system managed user accounts and privileges.
