- 1. How cars are owned by each department and agency in your portfolio?

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5. How far did each car travel this financial year to date?

#### Answer

- 1. As at 31 May 2012, DPS had 10 corporate cars leased through LeasePlan—seven of which are part of the Executive Vehicle Scheme (EVS) and three are maintenance vehicles.
- 2. The cars are located at Parliament House, and are home garaged or garaged on site overnight.
- 3. The cars under the EVS are used for personal and official use by the relevant staff member. These cars may also be used for reasonable official use by other staff members during office hours when the cars are at the workplace. The three maintenance vehicles are used for general on-site maintenance and gardening work.
