Q2. The ANAO has spent \$1,214,855.06 on travel in the 2011-12 year to April 2012. Travel of \$913,150.80 related to direct audit activities and \$301,704.26 related to travel associated with audit conferences and meetings, corporate activities and professional development activities. The ANAO's travel management system does not record information to the level of detail requested by the committee. However, we estimate that \$228,009.45 was spent on airfares and the remaining \$986,845.61 was spent on other travel related services.
