Can you provide to the committee, Mr Dacey, a comparison of this reporting period with the previous reporting period?

What was the average per capita executive remuneration between the two most recent reporting periods?

**Answer:**

The answer provided to me by the Australian Electoral Commission is as follows;

The average per capita executive total remuneration between the two most recent reporting periods was:

2001/2002	\$138,285.65
2002/2003	\$143,495.41

These figures represent the total remuneration package paid to a senior executive comprising costs associated with providing a fully maintained vehicle, car parking and superannuation.

The information contained in the 2002-03 Annual Report also includes such items as Temporary Accommodation Allowances, Leave Liability, and District Allowance. These were not included as part of reporting of remuneration arrangements in previous years.
