Dear Senator Mason

During the Committee's consideration of supplementary budget estimates on 3 November 2003, I undertook to take two matters on notice, and provide further information on a third matter, if it was available.

P27 of the proof Hansard:

In regard to the House of Representatives standing orders relating to disorder, the relevant standing orders are number 303 to 306.

No earlier drafts of the security directive have been retained in my office. It is regular practice, in cases where a document is to be signed by both Presiding Officers, for rough drafts to be sent to and fro before a final set of words is agreed upon.
