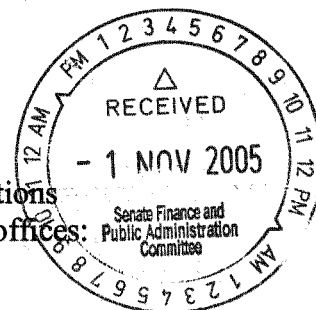


PERSONAL CLASSIFICATIONS
