Senator Parry asked:

You indicated that the intrastate and interstate travel for electorate staff is determined a little on geographical location and size of electorate—in particular the intrastate travel. I would like to know what the formula is. Is it five nights a year or 20 nights a year? What is that based upon when staff are away from the electorate base?

Answer:

The Electorate Staff Travel Budget is calculated at the commencement of each financial year.

The component for intra-electorate travel is as follows:

Senator or Member	Electorate Size	Amount
Member	$0-199 \text{ km}^2$	\$300
Member	$200-999 \text{ km}^2$	\$500
Member	1,000-9,999 km ²	\$700
Member	10,000-99,999 km ²	\$1,000
Member	100,000-199,999 km ²	\$5,000
Member	200,000-499,999 km ²	\$7,000
Member	500,000 km ² or greater	\$9,000
Senator	All except Northern Territory	\$500
Senator	Northern Territory	\$9,000

The intra-electorate component takes into account all travel within the electorate.

There is no separate calculation for Travelling Allowance within the electorate.
