### SENATOR EVANS asked on 31/10/06:

- 1. Please provide figures on the number of Carer Payment (child) claims, grants and rejections for each of the last two financial years.
- 2. How many parents have been granted Carer Payment (child) under the new criteria, which were announced during the lead up, to the Welfare to Work changes?
- 3. Could we have the number of debts raised in 2005-06, by payment type and the total amount for Carer Payment and Carer Allowance?

#### Answer:

1. Carer Payment (child) grants and rejections.

Financial			Claims
Year	Granted	Rejected	
2004-05	502	3791	4293
2005-06	591	4299	4890

Note: Claimants, if initially unsuccessful, may lodge subsequent claims.

2. Carer Payment was extended on 1 July 2006 to carers of children aged between 6 and 16 years who have a severe intellectual, psychiatric or behavioural disability or medical condition.

As at 1 December 2006, 430 customers had been granted Carer Payment under these new-criteria.

3. Debts raised relating to Carer Allowance/Carer Payment by payment type for 2005-06.

Carer Benefit Type	Number of Debts	Total \$m
Carer Allowance	10,660	\$2.7m
Carer Payment	25,073	\$17.1m
