SENATOR EVANS asked on 31/10/2006:

Please provide a breakdown of the Job Capacity Assessors, by main allied health qualification (e.g. occupational therapist, psychologist, etc) by years of practical experience in their current profession?

Answer:

As at 10 November 2006, the breakdown of Job Capacity Assessors by main allied health qualification was:

- 575 registered psychologists
- 269 registered occupational therapists
- 191 accredited rehabilitation counsellors
- 162 were social workers
- 77 were registered nurses
- 65 were registered physiotherapists
- 61 were accredited exercise physiologists
- 43 were registered medical practitioners

There were 216 assessors categorised as 'other' which mainly comprise psychologists who are in their final term of training working under the supervision of a registered psychologist but are not yet fully registered.

Data is not available on Job Capacity Assessors' years of practical experience in their current profession.

To prepare this answer it has taken approximately 10 hours at an estimated cost of \$538.
