#### Answer:

No money was paid to Cambridge University Press to act as publisher of the Garnaut Climate Change Review Final Report. The Commonwealth granted a non-exclusive, worldwide license to reproduce and distribute the Final Report to Cambridge University Press free of charge. The Commonwealth retains the copyright in the Final Report, which is available online free of charge. The Department of Climate Change purchased 2000 public good copies of the Final Report from Cambridge University Press for \$63,800 for distribution to relevant parties.

Wilton Hanford Hanover was contracted to provide production management, editorial, design, HTML production, advance copy printing and indexing services for the Final Report.

How many copies of the Final Report were printed and how many distributed? How many remain available and where are the remainder stored? How many copies have been sold and how many have been given away?

#### Answer:

The Department of Climate Change purchased 2000 public good copies of the Garnaut Climate Change Review Final Report from Cambridge University Press. As of 26 November 2008 1,816 of these have been distributed free of charge to relevant parties including, but not limited to, the following:

- All Federal Members of Parliament;
- All Senators;
- All State Governors;
- Relevant State and Territory Government Ministers;
- Stakeholders from relevant organisations including business groups and NGOs;
- Libraries participating in the Commonwealth Library Deposit and Free Issue Schemes (LDS); and
- Australian Embassies, High Commissions, Consulates and Multilateral Missions.
