"When will the National Strategy for Energy Efficiency, due to be finalised by June 2009, actually start resulting in action?"

Answer:

The Council of Australian Governments (COAG) agreed on 2 October that "implementation of (a National Strategy for Energy Efficiency) will be finalised by June 2009, to ensure that programs assisting households and businesses to reduce their energy costs are in place prior to the introduction of the CPRS." Coordinated national action to enhance Australian households' and businesses' energy efficiency will therefore be under way in 2009-10, prior to the commencement of the Carbon Pollution Reduction Scheme.
