Senator Ronaldson asked:

With reference to the Commonwealth Government's whole-of-government vehicle leasing arrangements:

- (1) How many vehicles are currently leased by each department, including their portfolio agencies?
- (2) By department, how many of the vehicles in (a) above:
 - (a) Are powered by Liquefied Petroleum Gas or Liquefied Natural Gas engines;
 - (b) Are powered by hybrid electric-petrol engines;
 - (c) Are purely petrol driven four cylinder engines;
 - (d) Are powered by:
 - (i) Turbocharged engines, including:
 - 1. turbo diesel; and
 - 2. turbo petrol.
 - (ii) Supercharged engines;
 - (iii) Eight cylinder engines.
- (3) What was:
 - (a) The total cost of the Commonwealth Government's vehicle contract for the 2008/09 financial year; and
 - (a) The total cost was for petrol.
- (4) How many of these vehicles score more than 10 out of 20 on the *Green Vehicle Guide*?

Answer:

(1) As at 30 June 2009, there were 7,690 commercial and passenger vehicles leased under the whole-of-government Fleet Management Agreement (FMA). This includes all agencies that operate subject to the *Financial Management and Accountability Act 1997* and some agencies that operate subject to the *Commonwealth Authorities and Companies Act 1997* which have elected to use the FMA.

- (2) (a) 135 vehicles are powered by Liquefied Petroleum Gas. No vehicles are powered by Liquefied Natural Gas.
 - (b) 241 vehicles are powered by hybrid electric-petrol engines;
 - (c) 2,693 vehicles are purely petrol driven four cylinder engines;
 - (d) There are:
 - i. 1,020 turbocharged diesel vehicles;
 - ii. 113 turbocharged petrol vehicles;
 - iii. No vehicles are powered by supercharged engines; and
 - iv. 128 vehicles are powered by eight cylinder petrol engines.

- (3) (a) The total cost for the Commonwealth Government's vehicle leasing arrangements, inclusive of fuel, for the period of 1 July 2008 to 30 June 2009 was \$121,351,309 (ex GST).
 - (b) The total cost for petrol for the period from 1 July 2008 to 30 June 2009 was \$19,964,762 (ex GST).
- (4) Of the 7,690 commercial and passenger vehicles in the leased fleet as at 30 June 2009, 3,968 vehicles or 51 percent of the leased fleet, achieved a Green Vehicle Guide score of greater than 10 out of 20.

In preparing the answer, the following assumptions have been made:

- The dual-fuel (petrol / liquefied petroleum gas) Holden Commodore has been listed as LPG-fuelled.
- Commercial vehicles powered by a range of turbo-diesel engines have been included in the response.
- The response as it relates to vehicles powered by eight cylinder engines refers only to petrol powered vehicles. To avoid duplication, commercial vehicles powered by eight cylinder turbo diesel engines have been reported in the turbo diesel category.
