Mr Tune, can you indicate to us whether the regulations apply to ministerial Christmas cards or not?

## **Answer:**

All Christmas cards produced by a Senator or Member under the printing and communications entitlement, including those produced by a Minister, must include the statement:

This material has been produced at Australian Government expense by [insert name of Senator or Member].

Any Christmas cards produced by a Minister, either personally or from a source other than the printing and communications entitlement, are not required to include this statement.
