Senator Parry, while you are on this, there is another one that I would like to clarify. If you are responding to a request for information, such as a request for a copy of a day's *Hansard*, are you able to do that under the communications allowance or not?

Answer:

A Senator or Member may print and/or distribute a copy of *Hansard* using the printing and communications entitlement provided that it <u>does not</u> contain electioneering material.

A Senator or Member may print a copy of *Hansard* using the office facilities entitlement <u>regardless</u> of whether it contains electioneering material.
