I am writing to you in relation to evidence provided by officers from the Human Services Portfolio at the recent Supplementary Budget Estimates hearings of the Senate Standing Committee on Finance and Public Administration.

Following the hearings, officers from the Human Services Portfolio who appeared before the Committee have reviewed the proof copy of Hansard. As a consequence, I would like to submit the following correction to evidence from the Department of Human Services.

At Hansard page F&PA 125, the following appears:

Senator SCULLION—So that would be the normal process: to attempt to actually recover the money. So in each case you would approach the person who has been overpaid.

Ms Cooke—Yes, the receiving parent in some circumstances may agree to forego the extra money that they have paid; but that is entirely up to the receiving parent.

In correcting Ms Cooke's statement above, her reference to the 'receiving' parent, should in fact be 'paying' parent.
