Question:

During the last estimates hearings on Commonwealth Rent Assistance I was told that there is someone looking at the geographical breakdown of rent assistance recipients and those sorts of figures across different geographical areas. Is that information able to be described or tabled?

Answer:

The Department of Families, Housing, Community Service and Indigenous Affairs has policy responsibility for Rent Assistance.

While the Human Services Portfolio has not been specifically analysing the geographic breakdown of rent assistance recipients, it does hold administrative data on the number of customers receiving Rent Assistance for nearly 8,500 suburbs / localities across Australia.

The table below, relating to the September 2009 quarter, shows the information held at the State level.
