- a) Since Budget Estimates 2010, 10 permanent staff members have been recruited at the National Gallery of Australia (1xAPS6, 3xAPS4, 2xAPS3, 4xAPS2). These staff are located in the ACT.

- d) Staffing levels are expected to be slightly reduced through reduced use of casual and temporary staff and through natural attrition and consequential reorganisation of duties and responsibilities in affected positions.
