Answer:

a) The Department of Regional Australia, Regional Development and Local Government was established on the 14 September 2010 and commenced operations on 1 October 2010 when staff and the associated resources transferred to the department. There was no expenditure on staffing prior to this date. The total departmental expenditure on staffing (including salaries, allowances, superannuation, leave liability accruals, fringe benefit tax and other related expenses) for the department and its portfolio agencies for the full month of October 2010 was \$2,389,000. The table below provides an estimate of the breakdown for expenditure on staffing for SES and non-SES officers.
