RECENT TRENDS


The following data shows trends and comparisons in the activities of Senate standing committees:


- The 42nd parliament experienced an increase in the total number of matters referred to standing committees, increasing from 234 in the 41st to 309 in the 42nd. So far in the 43rd Parliament (at 22 September 2011) there have been 118 matters referred. This compares to 118 matters referred after a similar period in the 42nd parliament and 78 in the 41st parliament.
- The 42nd parliament also experienced an increase in the total number of committee reports tabled, rising from 396 in the 41st to 493 in the 42nd. Committee reports tabled thus far in the 43rd Parliament (at 22 September 2011) total 186. This compares to 151 reports tabled after a similar period in the 42nd parliament and 123 in the 41st parliament.
- The busiest committees at any one time during the 42nd parliament were Economics (maximum of 14 references at one time) and Community Affairs (maximum of 14 references at one time). In the 43rd parliament, the Legal and Constitutional Affairs Committees have dealt with a maximum of 12 references at one time (in November 2010 and May 2011).
- So far in 2011 (at 22 September), the Economics and the Legal and Constitutional Affairs Committees have each tabled 27 reports, and the Environment and Communications and the Community Affairs Committees have each tabled 17 reports.
- Currently, four select committees administered by the Senate are in operation (two Senate select committees and two joint select committees).

Staffing: the committee office FTE staffing level as at October 2011 is 62. Currently, all positions in the Committee Office are filled, with additional staff engaged to assist with the workload. There are no on-going vacancies.

Budget 2010-11: the operational cost for the past financial year was \$6.6m, marginally over budget (by approximately 1%).

Accessibility of on-line material to the vision impaired: the Environment and Communications References Committee completed its trial to convert to HTML a selection of submissions received by the committee for its inquiry into the status, health and sustainability of Australia's Koala population (report tabled 22 September 2011). The attached report from the secretariat has been presented to the Clerk, who has referred it to the Chairs' Committee for consideration.








