Answer

- 1 Yes, but that would be a breach of Security Operating Policies and Procedures.
- A CCTV Code of Practice has been established and endorsed by the Presiding Officers to protect CCTV imagery. The CCTV Code of Practice is publicly available on the Parliament House website. (http://www.aph.gov.au/visitors/CCTV.pdf)
- 3 Staff who have access to this system occupy a position of trust within DPS and are required to have a security clearance. These staff are also required to formally acknowledge and agree to comply with the requirements of the CCTV Code of Practice.
