Senator PARRY: Have any costings been done to make it a stand-alone system using its own unique structure, not connected to the PCN? If yes, could you give me the answer; if no, could you take it on notice?

Answer

- 1 At the time of the Estimates hearing on 17 October 2011, no costings had been done to make the CCTV Camera Management System (CMS) a stand-alone system.
- 2 An estimate has now been completed and the cost to make the CCTV CMS a stand-alone system—that is, a physically separate system—would be in the order of \$3 million.
