National Film and Sound Archive:

- 1. Total education expenses for NFSA staff for the 2010-11 year were \$129,202. This includes funding for studies assistance, executive coaching, seminars and a broad range of targeted learning and development needs identified by staff and supervisors. This would equate to an average of \$680 per ongoing employee.
- 2. Responding at the level of detail requested would require unreasonable diversion of resources. The NFSA Annual Report provides information on Developing Our People pages 120-22.

National Gallery of Australia

- 1. Total education expenses for National Gallery of Australia staff for the 2010-11 year were \$149,071. Reporting on every detail of the education and development would require unreasonable diversion of resources. Educational expenses for the year 2010-2011 totalled \$149,071, which equated to an average of \$569 per FTE
- The total cost of the Gallery's education and learning this FYTD is \$17,227. Reporting on every detail of the education and development would require unreasonable diversion of resources. Educational expenses FYTD totalled \$12,005, which equates to an average of \$54 per FTE

National Library of Australia

- Total education expenses for National Library of Australia staff for the 2010-11 year (including coaching and leadership training, excluding staff time) were \$399,222. Responding at the level of detail requested would require unreasonable diversion of resources.
- The total cost of the National Library's education and learning this FYTD is \$94,528. Responding at the level of detail requested would require unreasonable diversion of resources.

National Museum of Australia

1. Total education expenses for Museum staff for the 2010-11 year were \$175,103. Staff were reimbursed costs under a study leave arrangement. Responding at the level of detail requested would require unreasonable diversion of resources.
