A budget of around \$3 million in 2011-12 has been made available to the Expert Panel on Constitutional Recognition of Local Government.

c) In the 2011-12 Budget Statement by the Minister for Families, Housing, Community Services and Indigenous Affairs on Investing to Close the Gap between Indigenous and Non-Indigenous Australians, the cost of the Expert Panel on Constitutional Recognition of Indigenous Australians was identified as \$11.2 million over two years from 2010-11 to 2011-12.
