- How cars are owned by each department/agency?
- Where is the car/s located?
- What is the car/s used for?
- What was the cost of each car?
- How far did each car travel?

### Answer

- DPS does not own any cars. At as 30 June 2012, DPS had 10 corporate cars leased through LeasePlan—seven of which are part of the Executive Vehicle Scheme (EVS) and three are maintenance vehicles.
- The seven EVS cars are located at Parliament House during the working day, and are home garaged at private residences at night. Two of the three maintenance vehicles are garaged offsite as they are “on call” vehicles.
- The cars under the EVS are used for personal and official use by the EVS participant. These cars are available for reasonable official use by other staff members during office hours when the cars are located at the workplace. The three maintenance vehicles are used for general on-site maintenance and gardening work.
