## **Question:**

- 1. What was the total cost of media monitoring services, including press clippings, electronic media transcripts etcetera, provided to the Minister's office for 2011-12?
  - Which agency or agencies provided these services?
  - What is the estimated budget to provide these same services for the year 2011-12?
- 2. What was the total cost of media monitoring services, including press clippings, electronic media transcripts etcetera, provided to the department/agency for 2011-12?
  - Which agency or agencies provided these services?
  - What is the estimated budget to provide these same services for the year 2011-12?

## **Answer:**

- 1. The Australian Public Service Commission (APSC) does not provide media monitoring services to the Minister's office.
- 2. The total cost of media monitoring services provided to the Australian Public Service Commission (APSC) for 2011-12 is \$92,926 (including GST).
  - These services are provided by Media Monitors.
  - The budget to provide this service for the year 2011-12 was \$53,000 excluding GST. The media monitoring costs above budget in 2011-12 were primarily associated with the Australian Public Service (APS) Bargaining Framework process which attracted considerable media attention.
