Question No. 67

Senator Ludwig asked the following question at the hearing on 14 February 2006:

- a) What was the unscheduled downtime for ALEIN for 2001-02, 2002-03, 2003-04, 2004-05 and so far in 2005-06?
- b) Is there a target for unscheduled downtime?
 - i) If so, what is it?
 - ii) If not, why not?

The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:

- a) The ACC commenced maintaining unscheduled outage figures from 1 Jan 04.
 - a. 1 Jan – 30 Jun 04. Outage of 199.75 hours (4.68% loss of availability)
 - b. 1 Jul 04 – 30 Jun 05. Outage of 6.5 hours (0.08% loss of availability)
 - c. 1 Jul 05 – Present. Outage of 82.15 hours (0.96% loss of availability)

- b) Yes
 - i) 0%. The ALERT initiative has provided the ACC with funding to develop an operational capability of 6.8 day x 24 hour system national availability. This capability is currently being commissioned.
