Senator Crossin asked:

Darwin Detention Centre

- 1. How many people, have been detained there since July 2005 and for how long on each occasion?
- 2. Given that the upgrade to the Centre has not been completed on what basis was the Centre used during December and January?

Answer:

- 1. During the period 1 July 2005 to 17 February 2006, there have been 461 people taken into detention at the Darwin detention facility for various periods of up to seven days.
- 2. The facility in Darwin was used during that period to provide short-term transit accommodation for illegal fishers pending their transfer to immigration detention facilities in southern Australia.
