Is there a checklist of the things you need to make sure they know? I was just thinking of the case of Vivian Solon. There was a checklist when you deport them to make sure of certain things. Is there any kind of checklist to make sure that they know how to get to authorities?

Answer:

A *Removal Availability Assessment* (RAA) checklist is completed for all clients being removed from Australia. The RAA was introduced as a quality assurance measure in November 2005 and was most recently updated on 4 December 2006. The RAA must be signed by an SES Officer or State/Territory Director before a removal takes place.
