Senator Ellison asked:

- (1) How many staff, not including electorate officers are employed in the Ministers office?
- (2) How many department liaison officers or other department funded staff are working in the Ministers office?
- (3) What is the job and security classification of each of the staff in the Minister's office?
- (4) How many staff did the department initially provide the Ministers office following the swearing in of the new Ministry?

Answer.

- (1) There are currently 14 staff employed in the Minister's office.
- (2) Two Departmental Liaison Officers (DLOs).
- (3) The two DLOs are at the EL2 and EL1 level and have a 'Top Secret' and a 'Secret' security clearance respectively. Ministerial staff employed under the Members of Parliament (Staff) Act 1984 are the responsibility of the Department of Finance and Deregulation. The requirement is that all staff have a 'Top Secret' clearance.
- (4) In addition to two DLOs, the Department, following the swearing in of the new Ministry, provided 5 staff to the Minister's office for various periods. Currently, the two DLOs are the remaining departmental staff in the Minister's office.
