Provide the Government's position with respect to the statutory one per cent cap on the amount a radio broadcaster is required to pay to sound recording copyright owners, where the broadcaster chooses to play sound recordings for the commercial or other purposes of the broadcaster.

The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:
