Answer.

- 1. The current infrastructure varies across the range of immigration detention facilities, however trunk services to the department's facilities are adequate for their intended purposes.
- 2. The sewerage system is in good condition. No septic system is used by the Department.
- 3. The system is operating at near maximum capacity.

- 5. & 6. The upgrade is being funded and managed by the Department of Regional Australia, Regional Development and Local Government.
