### AE12/0061 & AE12/0063:

Hospitality and Entertainment: What is the Department/Agency's hospitality spend for this financial year to date? What is the Department's entertainment spend for this financial year to date? Detail date, location, purpose and cost of all events.

### AE12/0065 & AE12/0067:

Hospitality and Entertainment: What hospitality spend is the Department/Agency's planning on spending? What entertainment spend is the Department/Agency's planning on spending? Detail date, location, purpose and cost of all events.

### Answer.

DIAC:

- DIAC does not differentiate between Hospitality and Entertainment. The DIAC finance system captures information on expenditure for both entertainment and hospitality in a combined format.
- The total amount spent on Official Hospitality for the first half of the 2011-12 financial year was \$56 787 of which \$21 208 was spent in the offshore environment.
