QUESTION TAKEN ON NOTICE

SUPPLEMENTARY BUDGET ESTIMATES HEARING: 13 FEBRUARY 2012

IMMIGRATION AND CITIZENSHIP PORTFOLIO

(AE12/0076) Program: Internal Product

Senator Humphries asked:

- (1) How many FOI requests did the Department receive for the financial year 2009-10 and 2010-11?
- (2) For each financial year, how many requests were denied and how many were granted?
- (3) Did the department fail to meet the processing times outlined in the FOI Act for any requests?
- (4) If so, how many? Do any of these requests remain outstanding?

Answer.

As per the figures in the 2009-10 *Freedom of Information Act 1982* Annual Report published by the Department of Prime Minister and Cabinet and the 2010-11 FOI Annual Report Published by the Office of the Australian Information Commissioner:

- (1) (a) For the 2009-10 financial year the Department received 11 504 FOI requests (a total of 6 921 were requests for access and 4 583 were requests for amendments).
 - (b) For the 2010-11 financial year the Department received 11 724 FOI requests (a total of 8 057 were requests for access and 3 667 were requests for amendments).
- (2) (a) Of the 11 273 requests finalised by the Department for the 2009-10 financial year, (6 620 access and 4 653 amendments):

Access

- 3 485 (52.6%) were granted in full
- 2 598 (39.3%) were granted in part
- 537 (8.1%) were refused in full

Amendments:

- 3 679 (79.1%) requests were altered
- 326 (7.0%) records were annotated
- 648 (13.9%) were refused or withdrawn
- (b) Of the 11 177 requests finalised by the Department for the 2010-11 financial year, (7 511 access and 3 666 amendments):

Access

- 4 152 (55.3%) were granted in full
- 2 688 (35.8%) were granted in part
- 671 (8.9%) were refused in full

Amendments:

- 2 361 (64.4%) requests were altered
- 480 (13.1%) records were annotated
- 825 (22.5%) were refused or withdrawn

(All figures are rounded to one decimal place and may not equal 100.0%)

- (3) The department failed to meet the processing time outlined in the FOI Act for a number of the requests.
- (4) For requests due in 2009-10 (from 31 August 2009 to 30 June 2010 which is the period for which data is available), the department finalised 77.6% of requests due within 30 days; four requests from 2009-10 remain outstanding.

For requests due in 2010-11, the department completed 88.2% of requests due within 30 days; 63 requests remain outstanding.

Please note that the department measures compliance with its 30 days' service standard and a number of requests not meeting this service standard were still completed within the processing times outlined in the FOI Act.
