## **ADDITIONAL BUDGET ESTIMATES HEARING: 13 FEBRUARY 2012**

(AE12/338 and AE12/339) Program 4.3: Offshore Asylum Seeker Management

Senator Cash asked:

AE12/0338: What has been the value of all the Serco contracts signed with the government in 2007-08; 2008-09; 2009-2010 and 2011-12?

AE12/0339: What is the value of any forward contracts that have been signed with Serco for the provision of detention services as an annual figure?

## Answer:

The Department currently has two contracts with Serco for the delivery of Detention Services. These are,

- Immigration Detention Centres; and
- Immigration Residential Housing and Immigration Transit Accommodation.

The values for both contracts reflect a whole-of-contract service cost for the contract period June 2009 to June 2014.

The value of the Immigration Detention Centres as reflected on Austender is \$1,032,827,276 (including GST).

The value of the Immigration Residential Housing and Immigration Transit Accommodation as reflected on Austender is \$85,682,416 (including GST).

The value for each year is not identified in the contract.
