(b) What has been done to assess opportunities to minimise and possibly reduce the current administrative burden on Service Providers?

Answer.

- (a) The Humanitarian Settlement Services (HSS) Policy and Procedures Manual has been finalised and distributed to HSS service providers and the DIAC HSS service delivery network. It is revised on an ongoing basis with updated revisions distributed every six months, or as necessary.
- (b) Opportunities to minimise and possibly reduce the administrative burden on HSS service providers are being assessed by the department as part of a review of HSS reporting capabilities and scoping of proposed recording, reporting and accountability improvements.
