Senator Hanson-Young asked:

How many people who have been given Protection Visas in the past 12 or 24 months have applied for some form (of) family reunion under (the) Special Humanitarian Visa?

Answer.

For the period 1 July 2010 to 30 June 2011, 4766 people were proposed under the Special Humanitarian Program by an immediate family member¹ who had previously been granted a Protection visa – subclass 866.

For the period 1 July 2011 to 29 February 2012, 6321 people were proposed under the Special Humanitarian Program by an immediate family member who had previously been granted a Protection visa – subclass 866.

Data was extracted from Departmental systems on 5 March 2012.

¹ An immediate family member of the proposer includes their spouse, dependent children, or where the proposer is aged under 18 years, their parents and parents' dependent children.
