Senator Hanson-Young asked:

Refugee assessment and judicial review: How many people in detention are currently waiting for a decision following an IMR interview? Please provide the information by number (not percentages) waiting more than 2 months, 4 months and 6 months.

Answer.

On 13 March 2012 there were 358 people in immigration detention waiting for a decision following an independent merits review/independent protection assessment interview:

•	Number of people waiting more than 2 months	153
•	Number of people waiting more than 4 months	96
•	Number of people waiting more than 6 months	43
