## Question No. 58

## Senator Brandis asked the following question at the hearing on 12 February 2013:

- 1. Can you provide an update on the 500 sworn police officers that were promised by the current Government during the 2007 election campaign?
- 2. How much has been spent to date to fulfil this promise? How many officers have been sworn in?
- 3. Is this a promise that has been hard to fulfil give the staff and budget cuts the Government have asked your agency to make?

## The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:

- 1. The increase in Sworn Police Officers against the Additional 500 commitment was announced in November 2007. Please find an update below:
  - 309 new members against this measure have been sworn in as at February 2013.
  - By 30 June 2013, 341 new members will have been sworn in and a further 125 will be part way through their training at the AFP College.
  - By 30 June 2014, 455 new sworn officers will have commenced AFP service.
  - The AFP will achieve the 500 target consistent with the revised timeframe of 2014/2015.
- 2. As at 28 February 2013 the expenditure against this measure is \$153.8m. As at 28 February 2013 309 new members against this measure have been sworn in to the AFP.
- 3. Careful management of the budget has allowed the AFP to achieve the planned implementation of this measure.
